- Developing and implementing emergency and evacuation procedures

To achieve this we will:

- 1. Systematically identify and control all hazards and risks in our workplace. Where significant hazards and risks have been identified, we will take all practicable steps to put the appropriate controls in place to prevent any injury or damage.
- 2. Inform all employees of these hazards and risks and the controls.
- 3. Ensure all employees are properly trained and supervised.
- 4. Inform all employees of emergency and evacuation procedures.



- 5. Record all incidents and accidents in our workplace and take all practicable steps to prevent these events from happening.
- 6. Carry out planned self-inspections to monitor health and safety issues.
- 7. Ensure all employees are given reasonable opportunities to participate effectively in ongoing processes for the improvement of health and safety in our workplace.
